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Renowned for its variety and concentration of wildlife, **BOTSWANA** is a paradise for nature lovers and bird watchers. There are very few fenced camps with animals roaming free. Rooftop tents are a must on this trip as you get to immerse yourself amongst the wild. Spectacular sunsets, magnificent waterways and herds of wildlife are just a few of the highlights.



RAW - REAL AFRICAN SAFARIS

We offer a **13 – DAY**, Self Drive Safari through northern **Botswana**. Starting in Kasane (an entry point to Victoria Falls), we venture south to Nata and Nxai Pans before heading to Maun, the gateway into the unique Okavango Delta and Moremi National Park. We then travel north-east via Savuti renowned for its stark setting and abundance of predatory wildlife before heading back to Kasane via Chobe National Park. Botswana is the ultimate destination for many travelers into southern Africa wanting to experience wildlife in the extreme.

TOUR INCLUDES:

- Accommodation is predominantly camping with the occasional hotel/ glamping tent
- Vehicle hire with rooftop tents (self drive transport in 4x4, dual cab vehicles fully equipped for the wilderness). Fuel is included. Rates are based on 4 persons sharing and 2 persons per rooftop tent.
- All meals including breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals are prepared by guides and support crew over the campfire and some lodge/ hotel meals provided.
- All park and entry fees.

HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE:

- Nxai Pans and the extraordinary Baines Baobab's.
- Maun, the central point for Okavango Delta safaris where you can choose to take a scenic flight (extra) over the vast waterways.
- Moremi Game Reserve – exploring where the delta meets land and makes for spectacular game viewing and bird watching. The landscape includes waterways, lagoons, pools, pans, grasslands, and forests.
- Savuti within the western portion of Chobe National Park, famous for its predators, especially its resident lion and spotted hyena population.
- Travel through Chobe National Park to Kasane where we drop off our vehicles and farewell our fellow travelers with a sunset over the Chobe River.





COST
