Offer a **21 - DAY** South Africa, guided, self drive (or be driven if preferred) experience. Starting and finishing in Johannesburg, the experience is offered to small groups (max. 12 persons) with our tours tailormade to expose travelers to a large variety of unique experiences.

## TOUR INCLUDES:

- Accomodation in hotels, lodges and guest houses – typical 3-star equivalent.
- All land travel in self drive vehicles or small people movers for the duration of the safari.
- All meals (breakfast, lunch & dinner). Most meals will be prepared by your guides with a number of breakfasts & dinners which will be at restaurants and lodges.
- All park and entry fees to well renowned landmarks such as
  - Golden Gate National Park and the tiny town of Clarens. Experience some short to medium day hikes in the beautiful mountains.
  - Drakensberg Mountains – hiking to the tallest waterfall in the world, experiencing the spectacular scenery, drive up Sani Pass visiting the highest pub in Africa.
  - The Kwazulu Natal northern coast, home of the Zulu nation with its rolling hills & scattered villages. Experience the beautiful coastline of eastern Africa.
  - Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Game Reserve where we seek out the BIG FIVE in the oldest proclaimed nature reserve in Africa.
  - Visiting the tiny country of Eswatini (formerly Swaziland). A small landlocked country of only 17,000 km<sup>2</sup>. It is an absolute Monarchy and the last in Africa ruled by a King.





- Kruger National Park for more BIG FIVE viewing. The famous park needs little introduction and has more species of large animals than any other African game reserve.
- God's Window and Blyde River Canyon. On a clear day at God's Window, it is possible to see over the Kruger National Park towards Lebombo Mountains on the border with Mozambique. Whilst visiting the canyon spectacular scenery awaits.
- Animal rehabilitation centre at Klaserie allows visitors to be introduced to wild animals being rehabilitated for reintroduction into the wild.
- Soutpansberg Conservancy within Leshiba Wilderness is a hidden gem on top of the Soutpansberg Mountains, where the group escapes to a secluded mountain top retreat. Unlike most game reserves in South Africa, Leshiba allows you to safely wander amongst wildlife with no fence and no guide.
