TOUR INCLUDES:

- Accomodation including motels, lodges and camping
- Vehicle hire with rooftop tents (on ground tents available). Self drive transport in 4x4, dual cab vehicles fully equipped for the wilderness. Rates are based on 4 persons sharing and 2 persons per rooftop tent (on ground tents optional).
- All meals including breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals are prepared by guides and support crew over the campfire and some lodge meals provided **3 x dinners in Swakopmund excluded.
- Welcome and farewell dinner at the legendary Joe's Beerhouse in Windhoek
- All park and entry fees
 - Etosha National Park with all its wild animals – lion, cheetah, leopard, elephant, giraffe, zebra, buffalo, antelope, birds galore, plus more
 - Koakoland with challenging terrain, 4 x 4 driving, mountains and dry riverbeds, ancient trees, free roaming animals and very diverse cultures
 - Skeleton Coast with isolation, shipwrecks, seals and desert
 - Damaraland with scenic mountains, semi-precious gemstones and cultural experiences.
 - Swakopmund for a bit of civilisation, shopping and dining
 - Namib-Naukluft for surreal landscapes, wilderness and superb photography
